

## Working Paper Series of the Research Network 1989 (with GESIS Service Agency Eastern Europe)

Working Papers give authors early visibility. Research on scholarly communication has shown that, over time, visibility positively correlates with impact, which, in turn, positively correlates with employment and funding.

The series is free to authors and readers. Online Open Access ensures that working papers may be downloaded, read and cited worldwide.

GESIS – the federally funded German Social Science Infrastructure Services (Service Agency Eastern Europe) - and the Research Network 1989 are teaming up to provide an online working paper series. Like with other working paper series in the social sciences and humanities, copyright remains with the author. The series will push papers into the publication pipeline, thereby aiding authors in the process of preparing their work for formal submission to a journal or book.

Requirements for submission to the working paper series are simple. They are mainly driven by the following considerations:

- A. We need good metadata so that we can index papers and alert the largest possible audience through awareness services.
- B. All dissemination occurs online and equally aims to reach the active scholarly community as well as a wider audience – including countries that have low bandwidth.
- C. To principally enable readers to enjoy reading the paper on-screen (rather than having to print it).

Submissions in the English language are preferred. Authors must ensure that their submission is in good and fluent English. Proofreading by native speakers is encouraged but the responsibility of the author. Submissions in other major world languages will be considered if good cause can be demonstrated.

When sending your working paper, please follow these instructions:

1. **Metadata:** A title page with
  - a) Title
  - b) Author
  - c) Institutional affiliation (be specific, be findable via a search engine)
  - d) Abstract (200-300 words)
  - e) Keywords (four to eight)
  - f) Bibliographic codes (if applicable, e.g. JEL)
2. Please send a document in A4 format that is **single-space** only. Please keep all formatting etc. to the necessary minimum.
3. Footnotes, tables, literature etc. Authors are essentially free to chose their own style, but please do consider that on-screen reading is easier **if tables are included in the text and footnotes are at the bottom of the page.**
